Aspects affecting spoken language skill development, categories, and examples from the data.

Category	Examples
Collaboration	
- pair work	Many learners mentioned that pair discussions in the break-out rooms enhanced their spoken interaction: "Conversations and pair exercises really improved my spontaneous speaking."
- group work	The learners appreciated the discussions with the whole group: "Discussions with other students improved my communication skills. I was able to practise speaking in English."
Course atmosphere	
- error-allowing atmosphere	Several learners mentioned that atmosphere made participation easier: "The happy, inspiring and supportive atmosphere motivated me to participate in the classes." "Positive atmosphere, nice classmates and a cheerful teacher made speaking easier."
- humour	Many learners mentioned that shared humour supported their spoken skill practicing, one learner wrote: "We had fun during the pair work, we have similar sense of humour, it helped me to relax and concentrate on speaking."
- sense of belonging	All learners felt themselves part of the learning community as one learner wrote: "Everybody felt welcomed, even the newcomers merged easily in the group."
- team spirit	The learners valued the team spirit which encouraged to use the target language: "Really good team spirit, no need to be embarrassed about not knowing what you are doing."

- feed-back	Learners perceived continuous feedback beneficial, as one participant wrote: "My speaking skills were improved by the corrective feedback." Another comment: "Feedback from the teacher helped me learn better and kept me motivated."
- materials	Learners were satisfied with the learning material: "The used materials met my expectations and were useful for my purposes."
<ul> <li>versatile assignments</li> </ul>	According to the learners the variety of activities enhanced their spoken skill development: "Teacher's positive attitude and variety of tasks (music, games etc.), good mood for everyday life and joy of learning sparked my speaking skill rehearsal."
- well-structured sessions	Learners valued that the online sessions had a clear structure and the instructions during the lessons were clear. "I liked the way the lessons were organised."

- own effort	think too much in advance about what to say."  Several learners pointed out that besides practicing in the lessons they also practised their spoken language competence at work or free time. "I noticed that I didn't avoid the opportunity to speak English at work any more."
- self-esteem	The learners felt their courage to speak grew throughout the course: "I gained courage to speak even if I didn't remember the words."
Teacher	
- attitude	Many students praised the teacher's attitude: "Teacher's positive attitude and experience of working remotely helped me to learn."
- content expertise	Teacher's content expertise was valued: "Teacher's knowledge about grammar and pronunciation helped me to develop particularly my speaking skills."
- guidance and support	Learners felt they received guidance and support from the teacher. "The teacher was always willing to answer extra questions and repeated her instructions." "The teacher helped, if I didn't remember something." Also, in break-up the rooms the teachers support was welcomed.
- pedagogical expertise	Many learners mentioned that teacher's pedagogical expertise helped them to learn: "Teacher was clear in her teaching."
- technical expertise	Learners were satisfied with the teacher's ability to teach online: "Teacher's positive attitude and experience of working remotely."
- social interaction	Learners appreciated the teacher's way to start and end the lessons by greeting and catching up, as one learner said: "I liked how everybody felt welcomed when we were asked what was up."
